Position Summary:

In this role you will:

- To assemble finished product using sub-assemblies, parts, and fasteners according to customer specification sheet and company policies.
- To fabricate and install sheet metal in manufacturing facility.
- Perform manufacturing duties, including machining, as required to ensure the team meets all goals and objectives.

Essential Functions:

- Use hand and power tools to shape and smooth metal and to blend seams
- Uses machine and hand tools to cut, shape, smooth and form pieces to required dimensions. Solders, rolls, or rivets seams. Reinforces parts if necessary.
- Performs metal manufacturing work and fabrication of equipment.
- Sets up and operated machines such as drill press, grinders, riveters and light presses shape and alter sheet metal according to specification.
- Assembles fabricated parts at floor station.
- Checks customer requirement and blue prints to determine required assembly, exterior finish on product, and any special options.
- Assembles components by examining connections for correct fit, fastening parts, and sub-assemblies, per customer specifications.
- Sets up and operates machines such as a drill and punch press, shear, bending roll brake, grinders, and numerical control equipment which shape and alter sheet metal according to specification.
- Checks assembled products, comparing each to customer requirements, blueprints and BOM and Router instructions.



- Resolves assembly problems and reports other problems to Supervisor for assistance.
- Maintains clean and safe working environment in line with company policies.
- Read blueprints and guide sheets.
- Perform dimensional and visual inspections to blueprint using standard gages and CMM, and other quality procedures.

Additional Responsibilities:

- May perform product repair on items set aside by quality assurance department.
- Support production schedule by safely performing work efficiently.

Job Qualifications:

- Experience in intricate hand assembly.
- Manual dexterity skills.
- Ability to lift 50 pounds infrequently.
- Attention to detail
- High School Diploma or an equivalent with at least 5 years' experience in the field or completed a formal apprenticeship program and/or in-house company program.
- Two or more years of production CNC machining experience is required.
- Ability to read blueprints and work with measuring devices is required.
- Must be able to use all standard inspection tools (i.calipers, micrometers, height guages, and comparator)
